What you will need:

1. Crayons
2. Scissors
3. 2 small brads
4. 1/16" paper punch

How to make it:

1. Color your Pocket Poe
2. Cut out all the parts. Make sure to cut inside the arm-pit of Poe as well. Be careful with the scissors!
3. Use the paper punch to make the holes indicated on the main body and both arms.
4. Match and overlap each arm hole with the body holes. The arms should be on top of the body. Join and secure with a brad.
5. Put in your pocket and enjoy!

The Pocket Poe also makes a great bookmark for those quaint and curious volumes of forgotten lore!
